Disability Equality & Inclusion Training

Classroom or Live, Virtual

This course provides foundational awareness and understanding of disability equality in the workplace.

It introduces the social model of disability, challenges stereotypes, and equips participants to create respectful, inclusive, and legally compliant working environments.

It also explores how to ensure accessible communication and practical inclusion for employees with a range of disabilities, including mental health conditions.

Learning Outcomes

By the end of this course, participants will be able to:

- Understand the social model of disability and key equality principles.
- Recognise different types of disabilities, including mental health conditions.
- Apply inclusive communication and appropriate disability language.
- Understand legal rights and responsibilities, including reasonable accommodation.
- Challenge stereotypes and promote a respectful, inclusive workplace.

Inclusive Recruitment & Management Training

Classroom or Live, Virtual

This course is designed for managers and recruiters who want to ensure inclusive hiring and retention practices.

It offers practical guidance on how to reach candidates with disabilities, facilitate disclosure conversations, and manage reasonable accommodations.

It also explores how to address unconscious bias and build a culture of inclusion through the entire employee lifecycle.

By the end of this course, participants will be able to:

- Reach and attract candidates with disabilities through inclusive recruitment.
- Run accessible and fair application and interview processes.
- Handle disclosure conversations and implement reasonable accommodations.
- Address unconscious bias in recruitment and management.
- Foster an inclusive workplace culture that supports all employees.


